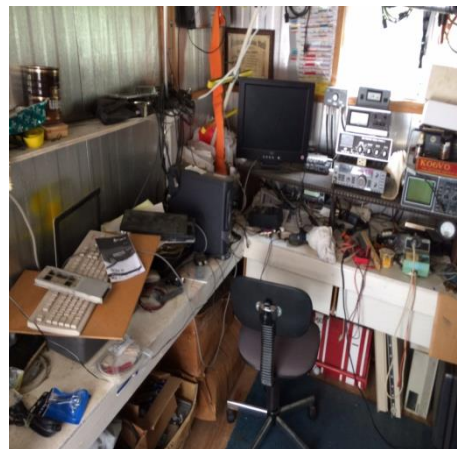
As you may already know, My father passed away earlier this year.
