• General Membership Meeting, February 14, 2019

- •
- <u>Call to Order</u>: In the absence of President, Mike Hasenfratz, WA6FXT, the meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by Vice President, Jim Veronica, WA6NXK. Jim welcomed everyone to the meeting, held at the Simi Valley Senior Center. There was a recitation of The Pledge of Allegiance.
- 8 Officers and Board Members/Advisors were present. The total attendance was 23, with 2 visitors.
- <u>Announcements</u>: Secretary John Percival, WI6O, read a letter of resignation received from President Mike Hasenfratz, WA6FXT. Citing health issues, Mike made his resignation effective this date, 14February 2019. John pointed out that Article II, Section 4 of the pending constitution calls for vacancies occurring between elections to be filled by a Special Election at the first regular meeting following a resignation. This will need to be addressed at the March 14 Club meeting.
- •
- <u>Constitution/Bylaws</u>: Secretary John called members' attention to the Vote Tally sheet that Bill Woods had provided for members in attendance to mark their vote for or against adoption of the updated Constitution and Bylaws documents. Members could also see if their E-mail votes had been received and recorded. Voting will remain open until the March 14, 2019 General Meeting. A "yes" vote by 2/3 of the paid membership is needed to officially adopt the documents.

- <u>Introductions:</u> There was a round of introductions for members and guests. The club welcomed visitors Yoshio Nakamura, KE6ACH, and guest speaker, Kevin Maiberger.
- •
- <u>Program</u>: Vice President Jim Veronica introduced our guest speaker, Kevin Maiberger, who has had a long career as a police radio dispatcher. Kevin previously worked 17 years with the L.A. Police Department, and now has been with the Simi Valley P.D. for 10 years. Kevin pointed out the big difference in the size of the L.A. P.D. with 10,000 officers compared to about 100 officers in the Simi Valley P.D. Kevin described how radio dispatching works between the dispatch center and police units in the field. Location information lets the dispatcher see where field officers are, and a video display with the city map helps to coordinate response to calls for help. Kevin said there is always a need for new people to train as dispatchers. He said most all dispatchers are civilians, and most are women. During his talk, Kevin answered questions about how dispatching works, and at the end he described a couple of the most memorable 911 calls he has handled.

- <u>Break</u>: A 15-minute break was taken, with refreshments provided by Bill Everett, KI6KSV.
- •
- <u>Member Drawing</u>: The progressive Membership drawing was held. The winning name drawn was John Percival, WI6O, who was present to win the \$20 prize. The prize amount will therefore start over with \$10 for our March 14, 2019 meeting. Members must be present to win, and the prize grows by \$10 each month it is unclaimed.

- <u>Prize Raffle</u>: Jim Hutchinson, KI6MZ, our prize chairperson showed the selection of prizes for tonight.

- <u>February Meeting</u>: The next meeting will be on Thursday, March 14, 2019. The program will be a presentation by Mark Weiss, K6FG, who will talk about remote-control operation of a home station.
