#### **Ham Network News!**

Version 3.20.3.1 of the AREDN software was released on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. It's an incremental update, based on the newly released OpenWrt 19.07.03, plus all the updates AREDN has made since the previous release (30.20.3.0) last March. Most of the nodes in Simi Valley and surroundings have had the update applied.

During a recent maintenance trip to Mellow Lane, the failed VOIP phone (ext. 4019) was replaced, as was the failed monitor on the Raspberry Pi used for telemetry. The sensors for battery voltages were adjusted to properly reflect the batteries' state.

That telemetry is available on the site's web page, like this:

A similar VOIP phone (ext 4089) will be installed at the Chatsworth Peak site before the end of the month.

A second VOIP phone extension (ext 4122) was configured for Glenn WA6GNB for emergency use.

(Simi Valley Hospital and the Simi Valley EOC at the PD have had VOIP phones in place for a long time).



When the failed network switch at Verdugo Peak is replaced (hopefully on July 31), the PBX there will be trunked to the Ventura County PBX, and calls will be able to be placed between user on the two PBXes.

Work continues at expanding the network coverage into Santa Paula. No deployment date is available yet, but with luck it should be before Labor Day. We've been promised (but no date) access to the tower on Rasnow Peak. By moving the node up there from the top of the building, the south end of the Conejo Valley will no longer be shadowed and will have direct access to the network via Rasnow Peak.

We continue to negotiate with the city of Simi Valley for access to their site at the water tower above the north end of Madera. Placing network equipment there will allow us to cut the LONG network link between Chatsworth Peak and South Mountain in half. It's the weakest, most problematic link in the mesh network in Ventura County, and as a result has less available bandwidth than other links. A 5 GHz user access point will be placed there for improved coverage in the northwest quadrant of Simi Valley. Ideally a PTZ camera will be placed there for viewing the inevitable brush fires. Funding is only partly in place for this project.

The Wednesday night Teamtalk night continues to be active. Between a dozen and two dozen hams check for an extended chat session, sometimes continuing for two hours. Hams check in from Ventura County east to Palm Springs and occasionally as far north as Wyoming (via an Internet tunnel).



The software we use on the network nodes is created and supported by AREDN, the Amateur Radio Emergency Data network (<a href="http://arednmesh.org">http://arednmesh.org</a>). AREDN will be holding their first annual conference online via Zoom on October 24<sup>th</sup>.


