



I have an assortment of voltmeters, and was noticing differences between readings. I got this part from Digikey, the LM4040AIZ voltage reference (the black dot in the metal box). It regulates to 10.0 volts 0.1% (+/- .01 volt) and costs \$1.79. Was easily able to verify and adjust all my meters.
