
Letter From The Editor



































Simi Settlers Amateur Radio Club General Membership Meeting, June 10, 2021

<u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order at 7:07 pm by President, Brian Hernandez, KM6MIN. Brian

welcomed everyone to the meeting, held over the internet using Zoom. 8 Officers and Board

Members/Advisors were present. The total attendance was approx. 16.

<u>Secretary</u>: Minutes from the May General Meeting have been published in the June newsletter.

<u>Treasurer</u>: Treasurer Glenn Daly, WA6GNB, reported the account balance as \$1,995.87.

Membership: Membership chairman Jim Parker, KJ6LXJ, said he had no news to report.

Publicity: PIO, Linda Parker, said she had not contacted the Simi Valley Senior Center, but she has heard

that some groups are starting to meet there again.

Newsletter: Editor Eric Oberg, KE6MLF, said the June newsletter has been posted. Eric made a suggestion

that when our Club can meet again in person, we have the first meeting as a "Meet and Greet" and

could include a swap meet for members who have radio related items they would like to sell.

<u>Election Time</u>: Ron Nelson, K6RIN, mentioned that it is the time for our Club officer election. The Club Officers

are elected for a term that ends in June and the new term starts in July each year. The Board of Directors will assemble a slate of candidates to present at the July meeting, at which time

additional nominations can be made. Then, the election will be held if a Quorum (one third of paid

members) is present.

Program: President Brian introduced our guest speaker for this meeting, Kevin Zanjani, Kl6DHQ, from

Bioenno Power. Over the ZOOM connection, Kevin gave a presentation about the Lithium Iron Phosphate (LiFePO4) batteries that they have been producing for over ten years. Kevin described these batteries and their many advantages over Lead Acid batteries. The main advantages include: Weight is about 60-70% lighter than lead-acid, very high useable energy capacity, very safe chemistry, internal protection circuit, and 2 to 3 thousand charge cycles with very long shelf life. He told of many applications of the batteries worldwide, such as in Canada where the cold temp operation is excellent. Kevin described the charging method and said the batteries do not show any "memory" effect. Also, the voltage remains very steady over most all the useable discharge time. For ham radio applications, Kevin gave examples of operating runtime calculations

based on the radio power and transmit vs receive time. At the end of his talk Kevin answered

questions and said there are new products on their website: bioennopower.com.

Member Drawing: Our guest speaker Kevin Zanjani donated a Bioenno battery as a special drawing prize for our

Club. Brian drew a name from our membership drawing can and the winner was Ron Nelson, K6RIN. Brian then made the drawing for the progressive Membership drawing and reported the winning name was William Cash, WD6DPX. William was not logged into this Zoom meeting, so he did not win the \$20 prize for this month. The prize amount will therefore increase to \$30 for our July meeting. While the Club continues to hold meetings on Zoom, members must be logged into

the meeting to win. The prize amount grows by \$10 each month it is unclaimed.

Announcements: Ron Nelson mentioned that the weekend of June 12-13 will have the ARRL VHF Contest. He said

he plans to operate portable during the contest.

Adjournment: The Zoom meeting was adjourned at 8:26 pm.
